ALL PATHS LEAD TO FUN ON THE NEW SENECA ADVENTURE TRAIL

The Seneca Adventure Trail at the City's Shaver Recreation Complex is a new option for both runners and walkers alike.

The approximately 3-mile trail winds through the woods directly behind Shaver Complex, and encompasses both challenging hills and slopes, as well as flatter and straighter sections of the trail. The trail was designed and created to provide a scenic alternative to runners and walkers that would give them access to a different kind of recreation and exercise venue.

The Adventure Trail hosted its debut event in July with the Carolina Reaper Challenge, a race in which participants were offered the option to do a 50k, a marathon, a half-marathon, a marathon relay, or a 5K. The event was hosted by Upstate Ultras and attracted a large crowd of runners on the hot, sultry July Saturday.

The Snowbird Challenge, a similar event, is slated for January 23, 2021.



Changes for City Events

A few changes are coming for Jazz on the Alley, Cruzin' on Main, and certain other City events.
