Warm weather brings outdoor activities.....and mosquitoes

The City of Seneca is making plans to begin the annual fight against mosquitoes in the city limits of Seneca. Here are some facts to help you plan:

- **Dates for spraying during months of May and June 2019: May 17, May 31, June 14, June 28. Future spraying dates will be announced.**
- Spraying always occurs in the evening beginning around 8:30 pm.
- Spraying will NOT occur if it is raining.
- If people are close to the area in which we are spraying, we are required to turn off the machine until we move past them.

IMPORTANT: Honey bees are an important natural resource and it is our sincere desire to protect them during mosquito spraying.

Check out **YOUR** City of Seneca Fire Department

The City of Seneca Fire Department consists of 29 full-time firefighters and 6 volunteer fire fighters.

The Seneca Fire Department is responsible for 5.5 square miles of City limits and 21 square miles that is protected under contract with Oconee County.

The Seneca Fire Department boasts an ISO protection reating of 2 within the City limits, and there are only 37 fire departments in the entire state of SC with that grade or better!

The Seneca Fire Department provides protection to its coverage area with 4 front-line fire engines and 1 reserve fire engine, a 100-foot platform ladder truck, 1 heavy rescue truck and 1 medical brush/response vehicle along with several administration vehicles.

In 2018 the Seneca Fire Department responded to 1,932 calls for service. This includes both fire and medical emergencies.

The Seneca Fire Department provides fire prevention for all elementary schools, day care centers, and assisted living centers throughout its coverage area. The Seneca Fire Department is also a child-safety seat check point with numerous employees trained in installation. Call us for an appointment!
