INFORMATION REQUIRED TO APPLY FOR RESIDENTIAL BUILDING PERMIT

Call each source for a list of information needed.

1) _____Two paper *and one digital set* (Thumb Drive) of Building Construction Documents and a *Building Permit*.

They must include:

- a) Complete Floor Plan with square footage,
- b) Footing and Foundation details
- c) Plumbing details and fixture layout,
- d) HVAC details, (Type and Tonnage or BTU's)
- e) Typical Wall Section,
- f) Truss Information, (Layout and Engineering)
- g) Electrical Layout and details
- h) Any other details that is not typical.
- i) Hand drawn plans must be neat and done in a professional manner or will not be accepted.

3)	Two site Plans and one digital copy (Thumb Drive) drawn to scale, showing locations of proposed and existing structures and distances to lot lines.
4)885-27	Certificate of Zoning Compliance (City of Seneca Planning & Development, City Hall 726)
5)	Flood Plain Check (City of Seneca Planning & Development, City Hall 885-2726)
6)	Sewer Availability letter (Seneca Light and Water Department, 864-885-2723)

7)	Sewer Approval must be provided from (Oconee County Sewer Commission, 623 Return Church Road 972-3900) or if septic system (SCDHEC 864-638-4185)
8)	_ Approved encroachment permit for City, County or State Roads from the following:

	Oconee County Roads – 864-886-1072
	City of Seneca – 864-885-2750
9)	Before final inspection can be scheduled the following must occur:
	Contact City Clerk at 864-885-2700 to ensure all business license payments have
	been paid.
	Copies of termite, duct blast and door blower, and insulation letters must be received by Planning Office.
	Please allow 24-hour notice for scheduling final inspections.
